Explanation	The member secretary explained Curricular and Credit Structure of all the		

	<p>programmes to be implemented from the year 2023-24. Prin. Dr Madhav Bapat asked if Major and Minor credits and structure formed for First Year B.A. courses follow the guidelines prescribed by the Government of Maharashtra and whether, at the end of the programme the percentage of credits awarded to the degree holder shall be minimum 50% for the major subject of the total credits.</p> <p>Prof. Dr. S. C. Thakurdesai explained that the pattern is in accordance with the options suggested in Prof. R. D. Kulkarni Report (page 22 to 24) as mentioned in the circular dated 20th April 2023 issued by the Government of Maharashtra and that the total credits gained in major subjects shall be more than 50% as is the condition in NEP 2020 Guidelines. Prin. Dr. Madhav Bapat was satisfied with the explanation.</p>

Explanation	It was brought to the notice of the house that as per the NEP 2020 structure to be implemented from the year 2023-24 different kinds of courses need to be introduced in the framework. Majority of these courses lay beyond the scope of Board of Studies approved by the University. Thus, there has to be a provision for the approval of curriculum and qualifying standards of the said courses. In this regard, it was proposed that, an Ad hoc Board of Studies need to be constituted.
