## About Workshop

At least one senior college teaching staff from science department and one laboratory or technical staff is expected to participate in the workshop. Maximum 40 delegates on first come first serve basis will be selected for workshop. The selected delegates will be informed well before 1<sup>st</sup> March 2024.

## About WRIC
