


But to implement this change, it was necessary to remove 'Modern Physics' from FYBSc Semester I and necessary to keep a 'Mathematical Methods in Physics' course as it is for SYBSc Semester III for academic year 2024-25 and to revise syllabus of SYBSc Semester III for academic year 2025-26 by introducing 'Modern Physics' course instead of 'Mathematical Methods in Physics' course. This revised scheme of courses for SYBSc Semester III and curriculum of 'Modern Physics' course were proposed and discussed.
