

Report on the implementation of autonomy for the academic year 2024-25

Name of the College: R. P. Gogate College of Arts & Science and R.V. Jogalekar College of Commerce (Autonomous), Ratnagiri (Maharashtra)

Ratnagiri Education Society's R. P. Gogate College of Arts and Science and R. V. Jogalekar College of Commerce has been awarded autonomy by University Grants Commission, New Delhi vide letter No F. 2-10/2023(AC-Policy) dated 31st May, 2023. Academic year 2024-25 was the second year of functioning under the autonomy. The college followed the guidelines of the University Grants Commission (UGC) in letter and spirit.

New Programmes

During the academic year 2024-25 two new programmes were added to the existing programmes at Under-Graduate (UG) level, viz. Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) and Bachelor of Performing Arts (BPA). Both are of interdisciplinary nature where students from any stream can enroll for these programmes. In lieu of the revised guidelines, BBA programme is to be affiliated to AICTE. Thus, the necessary procedure for registration, approval and enrollment through Centralized Admission Procedure (CAP) was completed on the Government of Maharashtra portal. As all necessary permissions and procedures were completed the enrollment for these programmes started from the academic year 2024-25.

At Post-Graduate (PG) level two new programmes are proposed to be launched in coming academic year, 2025-26 viz. Master of Science (Data Science), Master of Business Administration (MBA).

Nominations from the University, formation of Board of Studies, approval of the curriculum by the BoS and subsequently by the Academic Council was completed in this year. For MBA programme the necessary procedure for registration, approval from AICTE is completed. And process of enrollment through Centralized Admission Procedure (CAP) is ongoing.

The college is selected by the University of Mumbai for Apprenticeship Embedded Degree Programme (AEDP) in the first batch. The preparation for this programme is going on along with the University of Mumbai and necessary approvals were taken from relevant statutory bodies.

The college has registered itself on portals and websites like UTSAH, NAD, Autonomous, AISHE, Saksham, e- Samadhaan, NAAC, <https://www.antiragging.in/> of UGC and Academic Audit portal of University of Mumbai. The data is uploaded from time to time as per the schedule declared by the respective authority.

The college had registered on NAD portal and it came live in December 2024. Since then the alignment of student performance data output matching to the NAD portal requirement from the software used by the examination section was initiated. Confirmation of APAAR IDs of students was simultaneously done at faculty level. Till this date the data of 2245 (> 80%) students, who have successfully earned all the credits for the semester, has been uploaded for the calendar year 2024 and the process is ongoing.




