The initiation of educational activities started in the year 1925 in form of 'Mahila Vidyalaya', a school for girls in Ratnagiri town by Late J. V. alias Baburao Joshi, along with his wife Maltibai Joshi. Ratnagiri Education Society was formally launched in 1933 by this visionary couple. The visionary and a social worker to the core late Shri. Baburao Joshi nursed a noble dream of starting a multifaceted education institution that would work towards the eradication of ignorance and illiteracy amongst the cross section of the society of Konkan region of Maharashtra.

Over the years Ratnagiri Education Society has grown to be one of the most efficiently managed and run educational society in Konkan region of Maharashtra. Started with the modest school about in 1925 ago today the society now caters to 10000+ students annually. Presently Ratnagiri Education Society has over 18 different schools, colleges as well as vocational and professional training institutions under its illustrious umbrella.

With over 2 lakh students benefiting so far and thousands benefiting every year the society has taken firm steps towards realizing its dream; 'the dream of spreading education the light of knowledge the golden light of wisdom'.

About Gogate Jogalekar College (Autonomous), Ratnagiri

R. P. Gogate College of Arts and Science was established in the year 1945 by Late Adv. Baburao Joshi under the management of Ratnagiri Education Society. Later on, Commerce wing was added in the year 1969 under the name R. V. Jogalekar College of Commerce. It is the first higher education institute established in remote region of Konkan between Mumbai and Goa. Since then, the college has retained its status as the premier institute of higher education in Konkan.

At present the college offers undergraduate, postgraduate courses along with the research centers in Arts, Commerce and Science faculties. There are 25 academic departments running undergraduate courses, 14 departments offer postgraduate programmes and 7 departments are recognized as research centers. The college caters to around 3400 students coming from Maharashtra and Goa.

The college has been recognized by University of Mumbai, Government of Maharashtra and the University Grants Commission for its contribution since its inception. College has been awarded 'Best College award' by the University of Mumbai in the year 2009. College has received status as College with Potential for Excellence (CPE) in both Phase I and Phase II from the University Grants Commission. College went for NAAC accreditation process very early and got its first accreditation in the year 2000. It was awarded grade A in the 4th Cycle with score of 3.22 in the year 2019. College is awarded DBT-STAR grant in the year 2022. The institute is conferred with autonomous status in 2023.

About Ratnagiri

Ratnagiri, a coastal district on Maharashtra's western coast, is a land steeped in history and culture. Known as the land of Vardamuni, Parshuram, it is the birthplace of Lokmanya Tilak, witnessed the exile of King Thibaw the last ruler of Burma (Myanmar) during the British rule and served as the workplace of Swatantryaveer Savarkar. The district is also home to three Bharat Ratnas—Dr B. R. Ambedkar, Mahamahopadhyaya P. V. Kane and Maharshi Dhondo Keshav Karve. This region made a significant contribution to the establishment of *Swarajya* during the reign of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj, with an unbroken historical legacy stretching from prehistoric times to the present day.

The region's cultural vibrancy shines through festivals like Holi and Gauri-Ganpati, which draw people from afar, while its rich folk heritage is preserved in traditional dances such as Jakhadi and dramatic play like Naman. Ratnagiri is renowned as the *Mango City*, well-known for its Hapus or Alphonso mangoes. Adorned with sea forts, temples, caves, harbours, hot springs, beaches and scenic creek, Ratnagiri beautifully blends historical significance with natural splendour.
