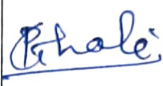

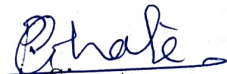

	1. To approve the inclusion of a 2-credit Vocational Skills Course (VSC) in the TYBA Semester V curriculum Explanation: The Chairperson stated that since the CEP work of the students admitted to the third year has already been completed, this change is being made to allow students to complete the two credits of the Vocational Skills Course (VSC). Based on the oral feedback from the students, it was informed to the meeting that the course 'An Introduction to Indian Epigraphy and Numismatics' will be included in the curriculum. It was also noted that the proposed course had been approved by the BoS. Resolution: The inclusion of the course 'An Introduction to Indian Epigraphy and Numismatics' for the two credits of the VSC in TYBA Semester V was approved.

	2. Dr. Sachin Joshi suggested that this VSC course should be made available to students from the other colleges. The Chairperson stated that the matter may be referred to the Principal for necessary approvals and appropriate action may be taken.
	3. The Chairperson informed the members that the process of recording student feedback on the History curriculum was initiated after the declaration of results and reported that 64 responses had been received up to the date of the meeting. It was further stated that a report based on this feedback will be presented in the next BoS meeting.
	4. Mr. Ninad Tendulkar suggested that other assessment types, particularly activity-based or source-based assessment methods, should be more widely used and incorporated into the curriculum.
	The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks proposed by Smt. Madhura Chavan.
