Agenda 2	2. To approve the revised course structure for the UG programme
Explanation	The revised course structure for the Undergraduate (UG) programme was presented before the members. It was informed that, in view of the revised course structure, the Vocational Skills Course (VSC: History of Media in Modern Times) at the First Year (FYBA) will be offered in Semester I instead of Semester II. Further, at the Third Year (TYBA), the existing Community Engagement Programme (CEP) has been removed and replaced with a Vocational Skills Course (VSC: An Introduction to Indian Epigraphy and Numismatics) component. Accordingly, the course codes shall be 26_AHSVP101 for the FYBA VSC and 26_AHSVP507 for the TYBA VSC.
Resolution	The revised course structure for the UG programme, including the introduction of FYBA and TYBA VSC courses with updated course codes was approved.

Explanation	The proposed two-credit Vocational Skills Course (VSC) curriculum and its evaluation pattern for TYBA Semester V were presented before the members. It was informed that the scheme of evaluation shall consist of internal assessment carrying a maximum of 20 marks, including 15 marks for Project Work/Field Study

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	Report/Survey Report and 5 marks for Attendance and active participation in the classroom.

	1. To consider and approve the revision in the Continuous Internal Evaluation scheme for UG and PG programmes. Explanation: The Chairperson informed that, under Continuous Internal Evaluation for UG and PG programmes, it is proposed to revise the distribution of marks. The marks allotted for Attendance and active participation in the classroom shall be reduced from 10 to 5 and the marks for Assignments shall be increased by 5. Accordingly, the revised scheme of evaluation shall be: Written Test – 10/20 marks, Assignments – 5/15 marks and Attendance and active participation – 5 marks (for 20/40 marks pattern). Resolution: The proposed changes in the Continuous Internal Evaluation scheme for UG and PG programmes were approved. Proponent Smt. Madhura Chavan Second Mr. Ninad Tendulkar 2. The Chairperson presented the salient points from the analysis of student feedback on the History curriculum for the academic year 2025–26. 3.
