Master of Business Administration (MBA)

Lateral Entry in MBA

Lateral entry into the second year of the **Master of Business Administration (MBA)** program at Mumbai University is managed through the Directorate of Technical Education (DTE), Maharashtra, and the State Common Entrance Test (CET) Cell. The process involves specific eligibility criteria and an online Centralized Admission Process (CAP).

Eligibility Criteria

Candidates must meet the following requirements to be eligible for direct second-year (lateral entry) admission:

- **Citizenship:** Must be a citizen of India.
- **Qualifying Degree:** Must have passed a relevant 4-year undergraduate degree, such as:
 - Bachelor of Engineering (B.E.)
 - Bachelor of Technology (B. Tech)
 - Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) (4-year program)
 - Bachelor of Management Studies (BMS) (4-year program)
- **Entrance Exam:** Must have a valid score in the MAH-MBA/MMS-CET or other equivalent accepted entrance exams like CMAT/CAT/MAT/ATMA/XAT (as specified by the Competent Authority).
- **Percentage:** Must have secured a minimum of 50% aggregate marks in the qualifying degree (45% for candidates belonging to backward class categories and Persons with Disability from Maharashtra State only).
- **Other Requirements:** Must fulfil any other criteria and requirements declared by the appropriate authority from time to time.

Admission Process

The admission process is primarily conducted online via the State CET Cell website.

- **Online Registration:** Candidates must register and fill out the application form online on the official website (e.g., mahacet.org).
- **Document Verification:** Candidates can choose between two modes for document verification:
 - **E-Scrutiny:** Upload scanned original documents online, which are then verified by an e-Scrutiny Centre.
 - **Physical Scrutiny:** Visit a designated Physical Scrutiny Centre with all original documents for verification.
- **Merit List and CAP Rounds:** A provisional and final merit list is displayed on the website. Admissions are then processed through the Centralized Admission Process (CAP) rounds based on merit and the availability of seats in affiliated institutes.
- **Institute Reporting:** Once a seat is allotted through CAP, the candidate must report to the allocated institute for confirmation of admission and payment of fees.
- **Eligibility Certificate (for other university graduates):** Candidates who graduated from a university other than Mumbai University must obtain a Provisional Eligibility Certificate from the University of Mumbai Registrar to confirm their eligibility for the course.

Mandatory Courses for Lateral Entry Students

(For students directly admitted to the Second Year of the MMS programme)

1. Students must **complete and pass seven (7) institute-level examinations** in the courses listed below. These are **mandatory for the completion of the MBA Degree**, although **no credits will be awarded**.
2. Colleges/Institutes offering the MBA programme will issue **Course Completion Certificates** for record purposes.
3. The course content for these subjects will follow the **NEP 2020 MBA syllabus**.
